- Up to five fellowships will be awarded for graduate students working on the intersections of food, food systems, sustainable agriculture and food systems AND structural racism (and other inequities) at HBCUs and TCUs
- Fellowship Award Year: September 2018 through June 2019
- \$4,000 stipend
- Professional development and fellowship activities
